


HEALTHY EATING

Fresh produce and innovative food from local entrepreneurs

The Mission District:

- Elevated levels of hospitalization for diabetes
- Elevated levels of adult diabetes and congestive heart failure
- Coronary atherosclerosis is leading chronic cause of hospitalization
- No community markets with fresh produce and healthy food

The Mission:

- Over 30% of residents are low income in 94110
- High unemployment
- High near poverty rate for those 18 to 64
- High poverty rate for those over 64 years of age


