Recycle = Blue Bins

Do put: Bottles and their caps, Empty spray cans, Egg cartons, Paper, Aluminum, Coffee cup lids, Junk mail.

Don't Put: Liquids, Food, Soiled paper, Batteries, Ceramic, Electronics, Wood, Incandescent Light Bulbs.

Compost = Green Bin

Do Put: Food Scraps, Soiled Paper, Coffee Filters, Yard Trimmings, Pizza Boxes, Milk and Juice cartons, Take out boxes, Wood, Ice cream boxes.

Don't Put: Plywood, Painted or Stained wood, Corks, Cooking oil, Clean cardboard or paper, Styrofoam , Kitty litter, Animal feces.

Trash = Black Bins

Do Put: Corks, Diapers, Styrofoam, Plastic Bags, Rubber bands, Cooking grease, Kitty liter, Pens, Pencils, Ceramic, Painted or Stained wood, Juice or Soy cartons with foil liner.

Don't Put: Appliances, Large Items (Furniture), Batteries, Electronics, Food or Liquids, Motor oil, Paint, Needles, Syringes, Dirt, Rocks.
