Possible models

- Originated in Hamburg Germany in 1964.
- The concept was to "coordinate" not "consolidate".
- The successful model quickly spread to other cities in Germany, then virtually all of western Europe.
- They now also exist in South Africa (Raboroko & Whitehead, 2009) and Brazil (Peixoto, 2009).
- The Association of European Metropolitan Transport Authorities (EMTA) was formed in 1998 to serve as "venue for exchange of information/best practices".
- Closest North American model is Montreal.
- San Diego MTA has some features.

- Stuttgart: VVS




















## Board of Directors of VVS
