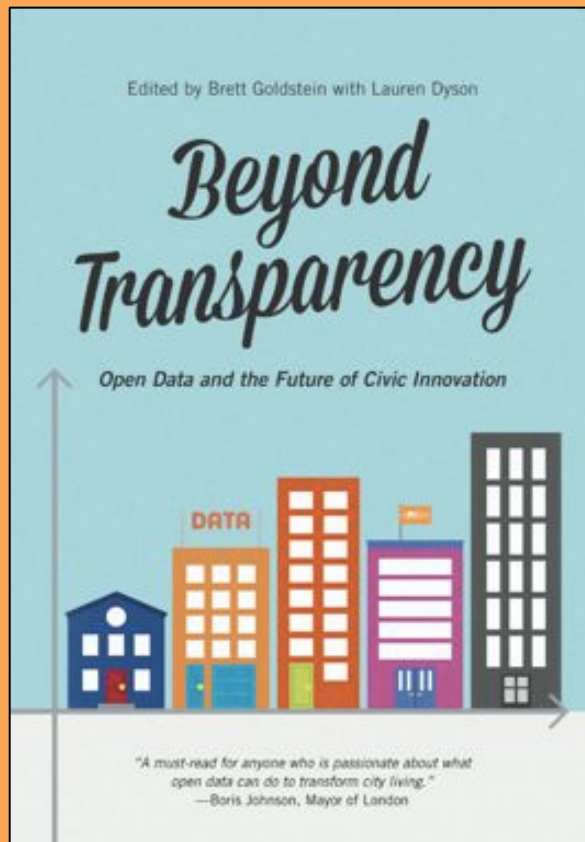
Three Easy Ways We Can Make Transit More Seamless
