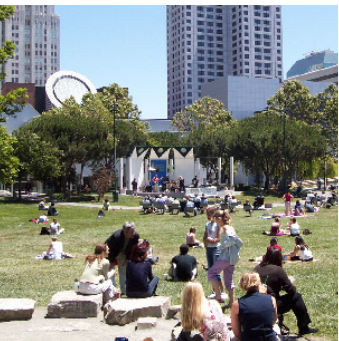

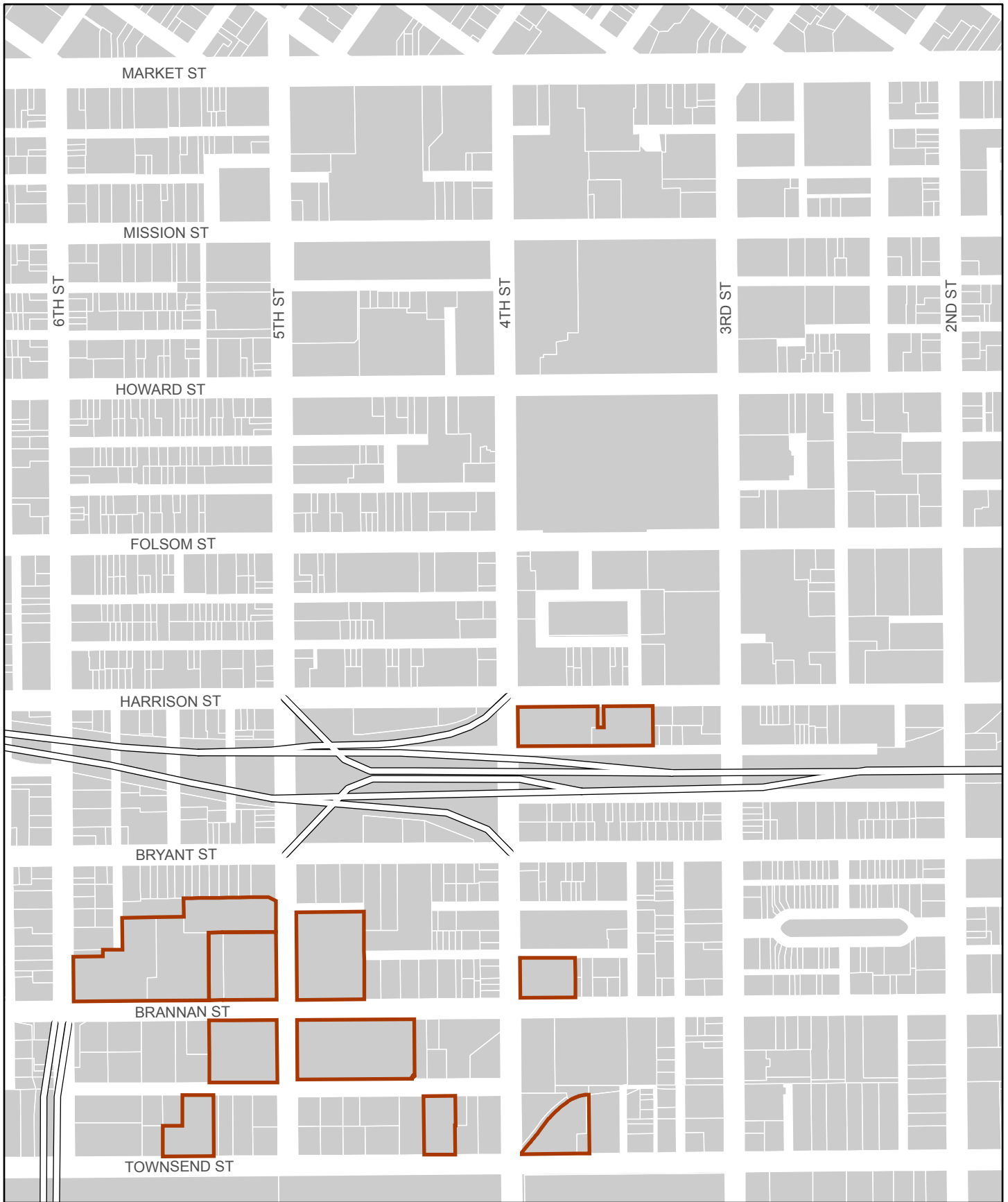

-  High Growth Potential (Over 4000 new jobs or units)

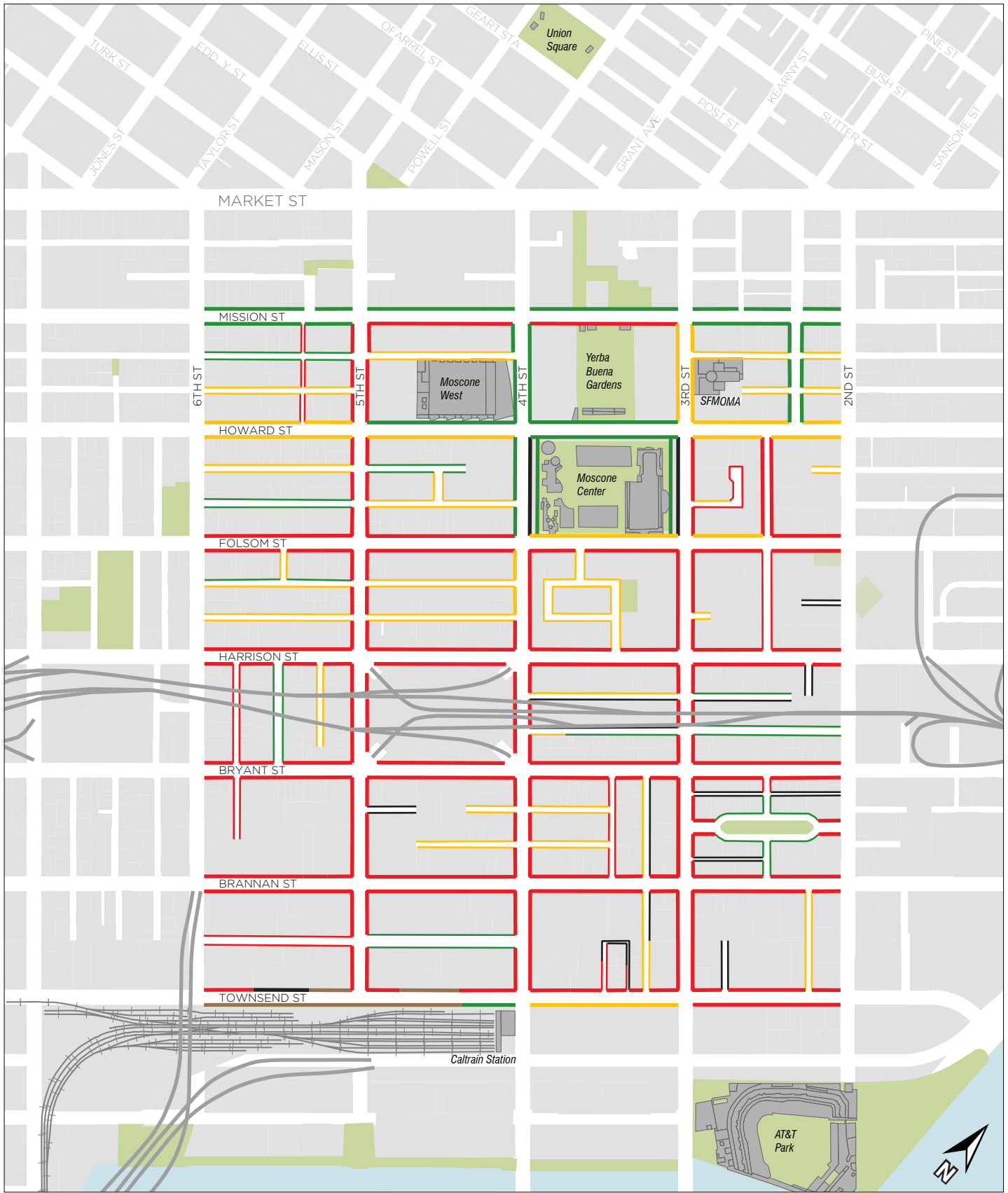
 Moderate Growth Potential (Over 1,000 new jobs or units)

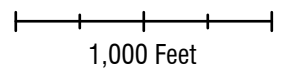
CENTRAL SOMA
Large Development Sites
(over 30,000 square feet)





- No sidewalk
- No sidewalk, pedestrian walkway provided (no curb)
- Sidewalk width less than Better Streets Plan (BSP) minimum (12' for major streets, 9' other)
- Sidewalk width meets BSP minimum but less than recommended (15' for major streets, 12' other)
- Sidewalk width meets BSP recommended width
