














SITE ANALYSIS UN Plaza Events & Preliminary Site Plan



- 28 moved into permanent employment
- 21 moved in temp or seasonal employment
- Over 9,500 needles removed from Civic Center/ UN Plaza project area
- Over 219,177 gallons of debris removed
