


# TODAY? SF AND SAN JOSE HOMES COST BETWEEN 9-10X MEDIAN INCOMES




## CALIFORNIA HOME PRICES HAVE GROWN MUCH FASTER THAN THE U.S. SINCE THE 1970S





## HOMEOWNERSHIP RATES AMONG 25-35 YEAR OLDS USED TO BE CLOSE TO 50% IN THE 1960S




# SF RETAINS VERY LOW-INCOME & VERY HIGH-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS



### POPULATION GROWTH





Share of All County Households, by Income Segment, 1989 to 2014















## Where Is Population Growing?




