

Map: SPUR, Rethinking the Corporate Campus, April 2017





Incomplete regional express bus network with multiple providers.

Service varies widely and fluctuates annually with local budgets.

Doesn't function as a network.


Difficult for the public to determine what's available.






Little priority for higher occupancy modes (including transit) or incentives to take transit/carpool on our highways.

Buses stuck in traffic, even in areas where carpool lanes that do exist.




MTC Managed Lanes Implementation Survey

- 71% of respondents currently drive alone
- Over half would use an express bus if it was reliably 10 minutes faster than driving in a regular lane




