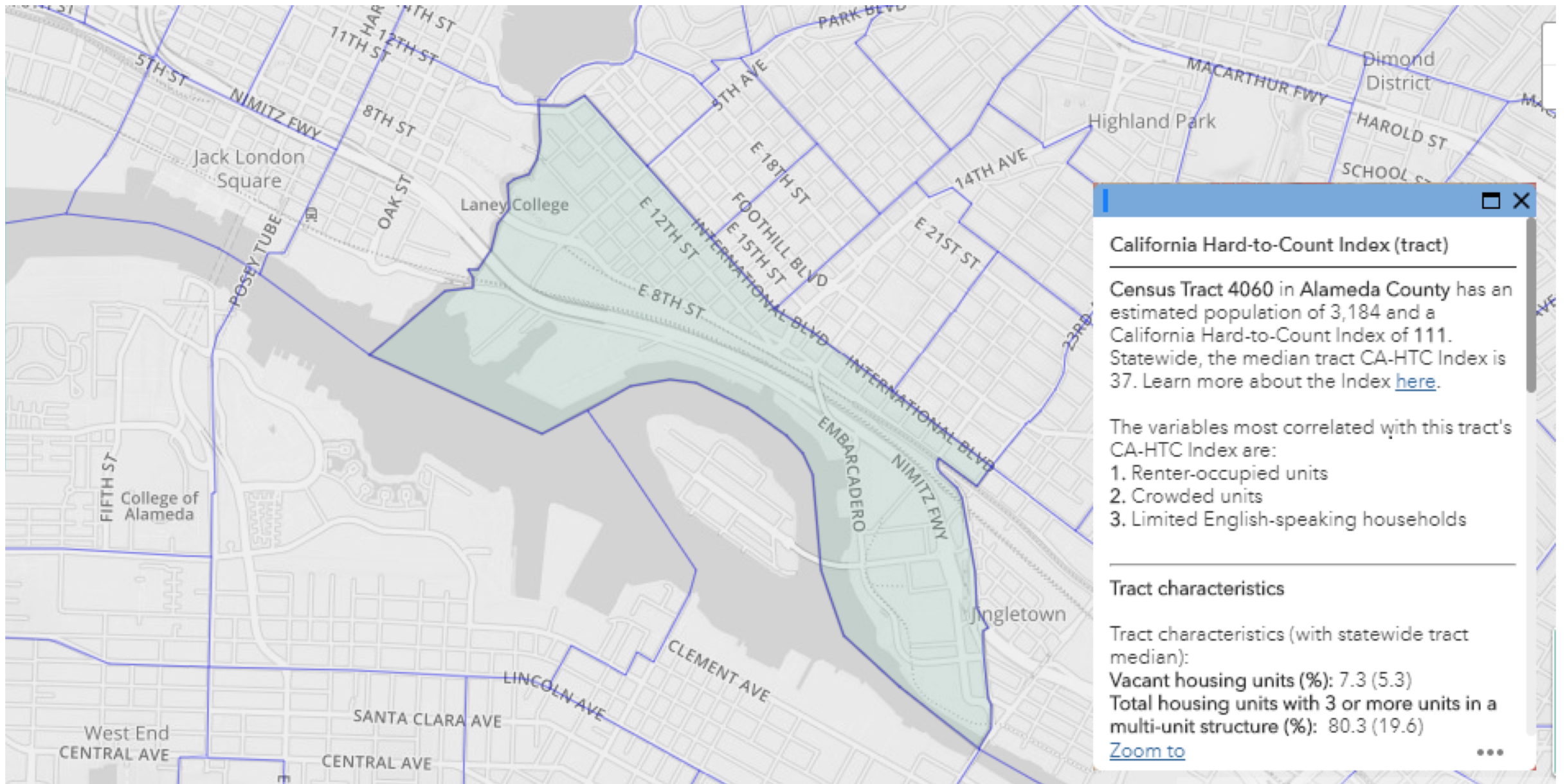


# Census 2020: Everyone Counts



### California Hard-to-Count Index (tract)

Census Tract 4060 in Alameda County has an estimated population of 3,184 and a California Hard-to-Count Index of 111. Statewide, the median tract CA-HTC Index is 37. Learn more about the Index [here](#).

The variables most correlated with this tract's CA-HTC Index are:

- 1. Renter-occupied units
- 2. Crowded units
- 3. Limited English-speaking households
