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Overview

- Began operation in December 2009
- Operates along two freeway corridors (I-110 & I-10)
- Created by restructuring four existing express services
 - Freeway portions of lines 444, 446/447,484 & 490 consolidated into Silver Line
 - Local portion of lines continue as local services
- Enhanced service on HOV lanes by providing more frequent & reliable service with even headways




Benefits

- Reduces Service Duplication
 - Consolidate overlapping downtown routes
 - Eliminate 123 (30%) daily oneway bus trips in downtown Los Angeles
- Improves On-Time Performance
 - Shorter local feeder routes improved OTP by 21%
- Reduces Metro Operating Expense
 - 13,000 fewer annual revenue service hours
 - Projected annual operating cost savings of \$1,040,000

- 27 miles, 7 in-line stations
- Buses branded in silver color and specialized graphics
- Frequency improvements throughout the day and week

Infrastructure

- Redeveloped El Monte Station
- New Patsaouras Plaza Station
- Planned improvements at all Harbor Transitway Stations including signage, shelter, security, artwork, restroom at Harbor/Gateway Station
- Transit Signal Priority and peak bus only lane along Figueroa and Flower St



- 249 avg. weekday boardings (Apr 2019)








CSULA Station
