

Policy Action Across U.S. to Shift Buildings off Gas

Washington: State investigation on future of gas and BE, including line extension policies; Existing buildings performance standard; Multiple city BE codes for new and existing buildings

Oregon: Statewide Natural Gas Fact Finding; Cities adopt BE requirements

California: CPUC Future of Gas proceeding, Air Districts and CARB considering zero-pollution standards for appliances, +50 cities adopted BE codes, statewide building code, \$1 bil in state budget for Decarb, utility BE incentives....

Minnesota: Statewide proceeding to evaluate changes to gas utility regulation

Nevada: Statewide future of gas proceeding

Colorado: Multiple proceedings on decarb and BE; multiple cities adopt BE codes, pending statewide legislation on decarb building codes

Illinois: Allows utility EE funds to be used for electrification

New York: Statewide gas planning proceedings; NYC and Ithaca BE commitments and requirements for new and existing buildings

DC: Altagas Climate Business Plan; Buildings Emissions Standard

Vermont: City BE codes

Massachusetts: State investigation in future of gas utilities; Boston building emissions standard; proposal for over \$800 million for BE in next 3-year EE program

Federal:

- Exec Order: zero-carbon for federal buildings x 2045 + all-electric new construction
- Infrastructure Bill: \$6 bil for retrofits (WAP, etc)
- Gas appliances removed from EnergyStar “most efficient” rating
