

Driveway Permit - \$170 one-time fee – good for term of ownership or lease

Residents of single-family homes may apply for a Driveway Parking Permit to park in front of their residence, blocking their driveway. After an application is submitted to the City, the driveway shall be inspected for prior to permit approval. After paying a one-time fee, the permit shall be good for the term of ownership or lease.

Required Documentation

- **Proof of Residency** - required documentation less than 30 days old must be provided (may be any one of the following):
 - Current utility bill, bank statement, credit card bill, or a bill/statement sent through the mail on a monthly billing cycle (the only online print-out accepted is a current utility bill showing the service address, not the mailing address)
 - Rental / lease agreement signed within the last 30 days
 - Proof of property ownership--tax bill or new escrow papers
- **Valid Picture I.D.** Acceptable forms include a driver's license, California I.D., passport or military I.D.

Eligibility

- Driveway Permits will be issued to single family residences only, not multiple dwelling parking spaces or multiple commercial use parking spaces.

Restrictions

- Driveway Permit Display Vehicles not properly displaying the Driveway Permit are subject to citation.
- Cars extending beyond the width of the driveway at any point are subject to citation.
- The permit does not authorize parking on a sidewalk in violation of California Vehicle Code Section 22500 (f).
